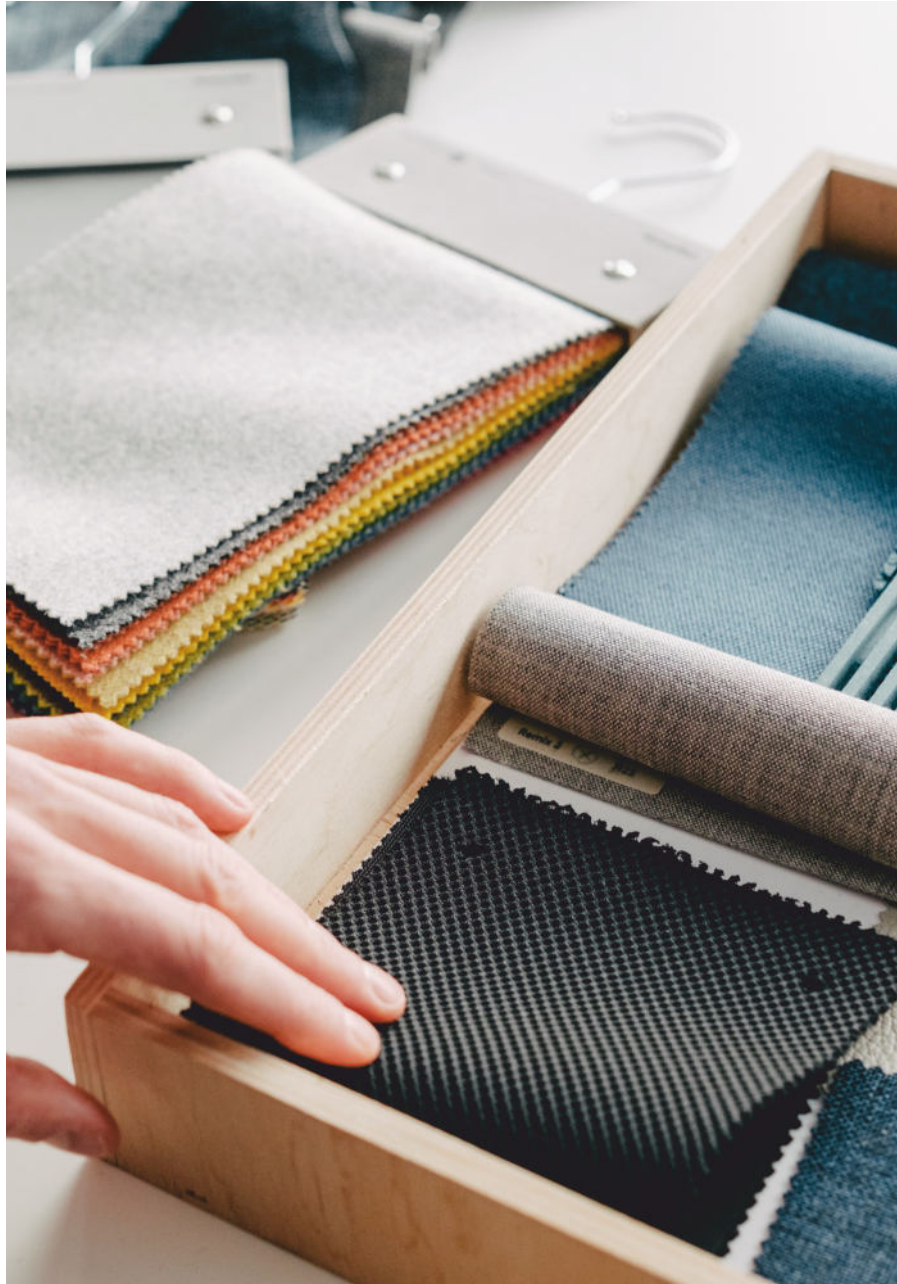

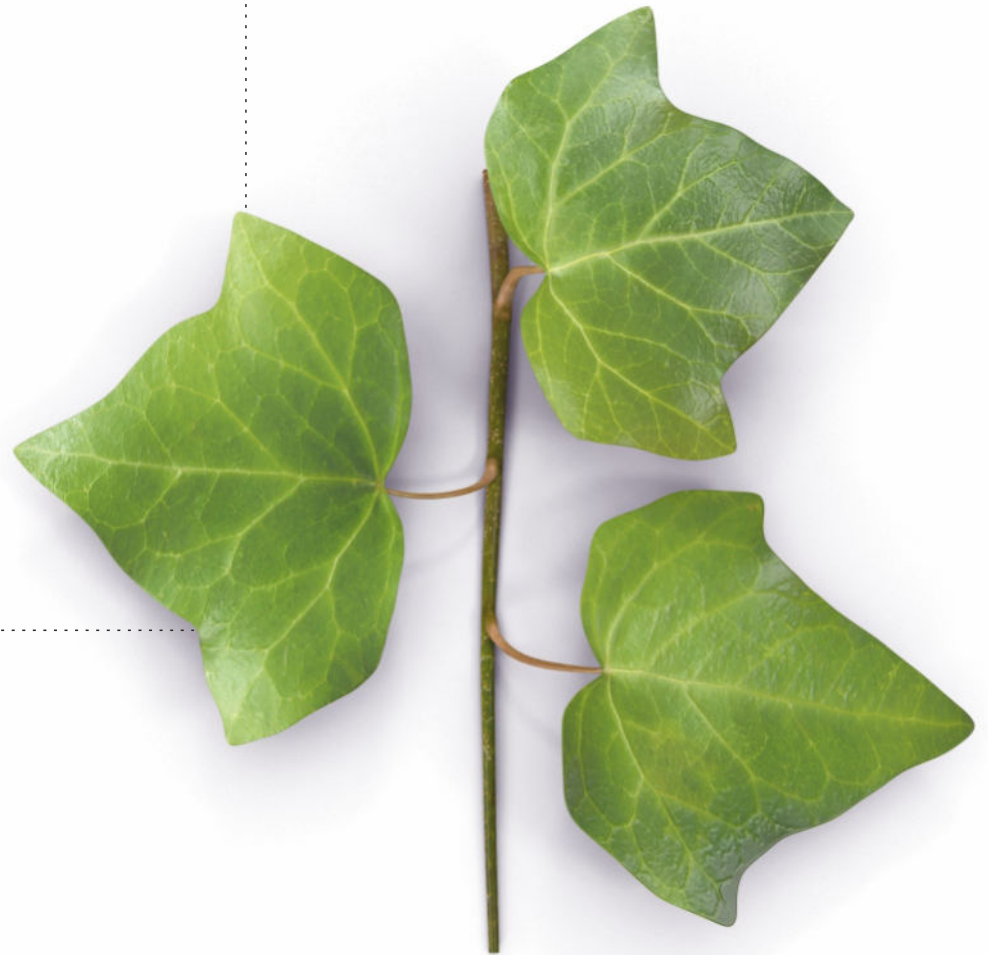

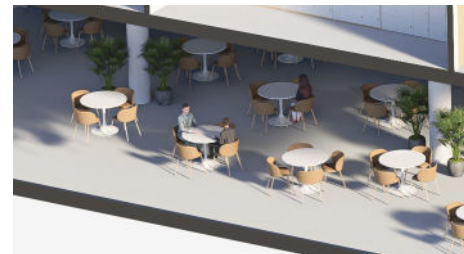

Waiting zones



Some chairs and benches have raised seat option, ideal for people with reduced mobility.

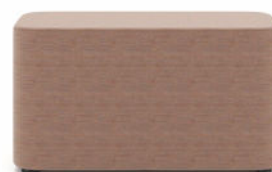

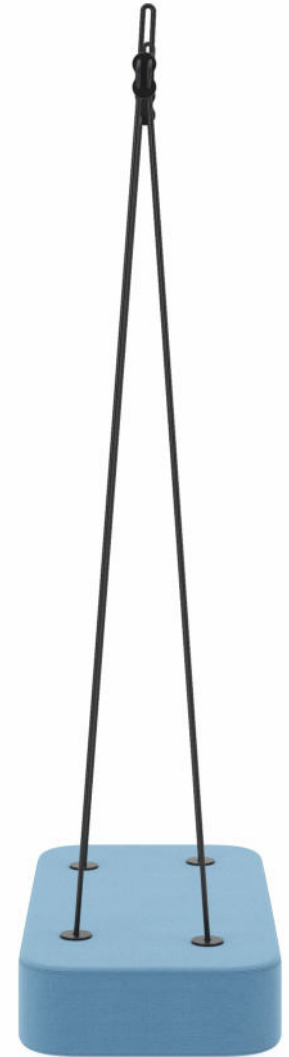

Individual therapy rooms are spaces adjusted to specific types of work. A psychologist's or nutritionist's office will differ from a traditional doctor's office. Instead of medical furniture, you will see comfortable armchairs, sofas and coffee tables, which makes the entire space look homely. This facilitates building a relationship between a specialist and a patient.

The arrangement focuses on building an atmosphere of emotional support and rapport. Soft finishes, noise-absorbing materials, subtle lighting and neutral colour options reduce stress and help people focus on the conversation at hand.

Patients' rooms

Multiple patient rooms in hospitals combine comfort and functionality. Beds, bedside tables and chairs are easily accessible and a deliberately designed space for visitors allows the family members to spend time with the patient. The materials are easy to clean and hygienic. The layout of the rooms ensures privacy, comfort and relaxation, and minimises any stress related to the experience of hospitalisation, at the same time enabling effective medical care.

Patients' rooms

- **reduced connections and gaps**

Furniture construction without hard-to-reach areas, gaps or seams minimises the risk of dirt accumulation and facilitates disinfection.

- **resistance to disinfectants**

furniture resistant to harsh disinfectants allows effective decontamination without damaging the surface.

- **stress reduction**

comfortable, ergonomic furniture supports the recovery and healing process, which can shorten hospital stays and reduce the risk of secondary infections.



Seats are certified for use by heavier people up to 150 or 180 kg. Raised armrests for better forearm support and easier sitting down or standing up. This construction also makes it easier to slide the chair or armchair under a table.

Rooms for long-term stay are designed to ensure proper living conditions for patients who require a lengthy treatment. Furniture such as beds, spacious lockers, desks and chairs are positioned in a way that enables comfortable navigation and leaves space for personal organisation.

The Care armchair – this product is specifically designed to meet the needs of patients with reduced mobility, who require extra assistance.

It can come with an IV stand and a special table. The castor version allows the patient to be moved in a seated position.

Social zones

The patient social area is a space for relaxation and integration. A spacious room, equipped with comfortable armchairs, sofas and tables, makes it possible for patients to interact with one another and meet with their relatives, which is a great mental and emotional support in the difficult process of recovery.

A social zone for the hospital staff is a place where they can chill out during a break. It is complete with comfortable armchairs, tables and a kitchenette. The furniture and spatial arrangement support comfort and functionality, encouraging regeneration during intensive work.

Social zones

The rooms where patients or their families talk to physicians are designed to ensure privacy and comfort during important conversations. Comfortable and ergonomic chairs or armchairs, and a table help create a suitable space for an open and amicable discussion. In such spaces, physicians should have access to necessary documentation and technology without disturbing the atmosphere of intimacy and trust.

Hospital corridors and waiting rooms often lack acoustic privacy, which may cause discomfort during sensitive medical conversations.

It is worth considering separate visual and acoustic zones to accommodate difficult conversations so that specialists can talk to patients or their families in privacy, far from other visitors.
